



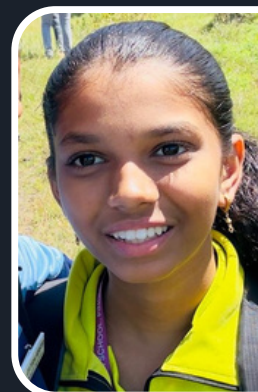

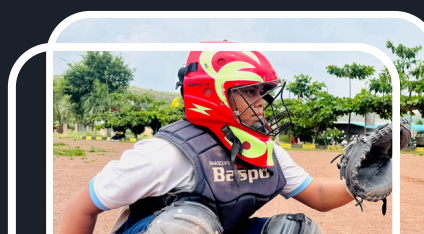

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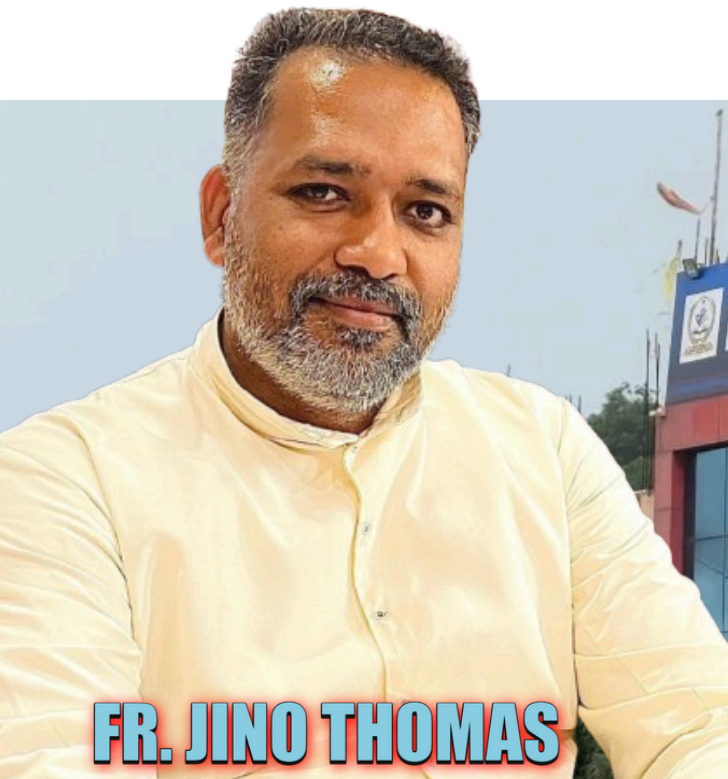

Dear Students, Parents, and Guardians,

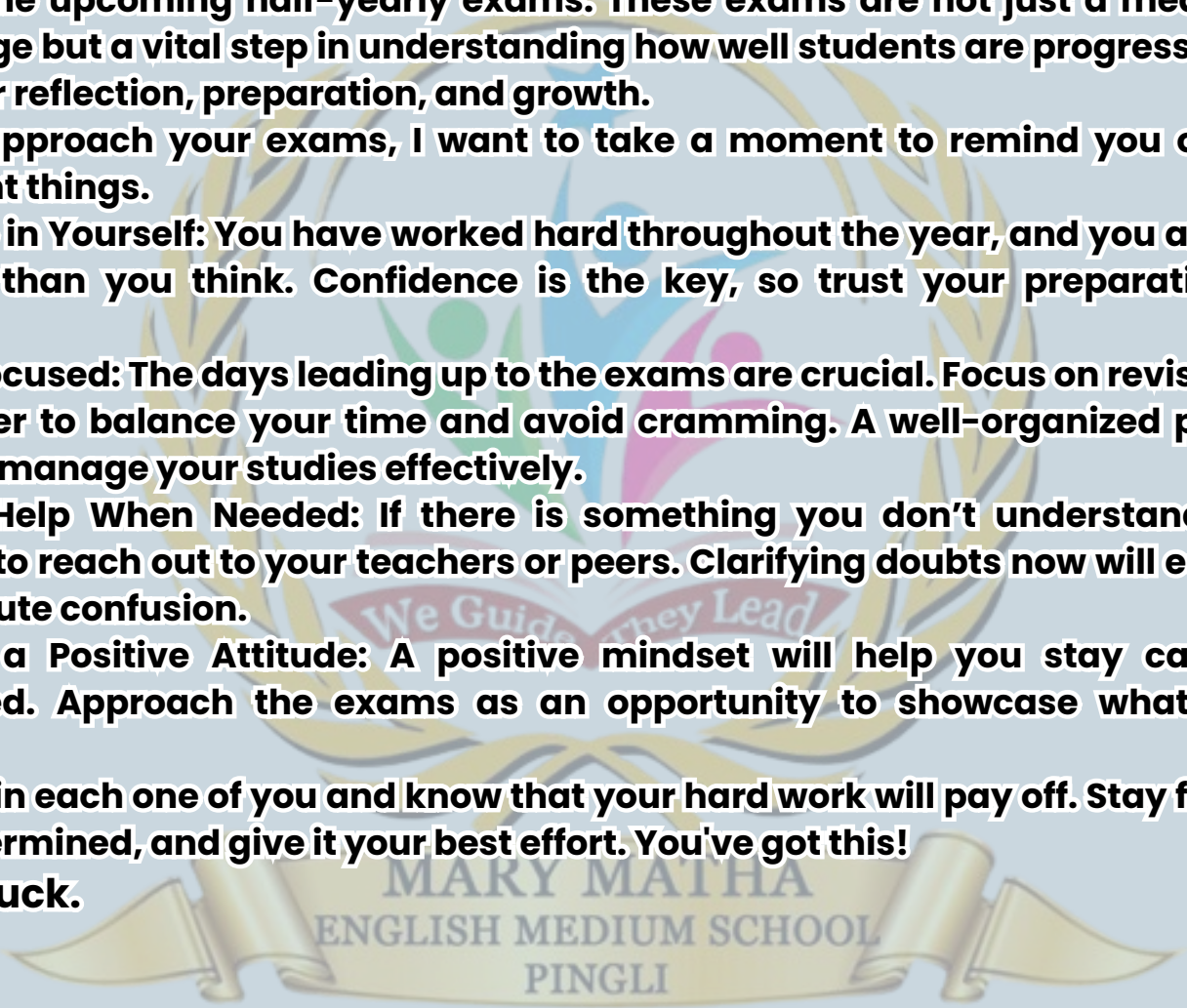

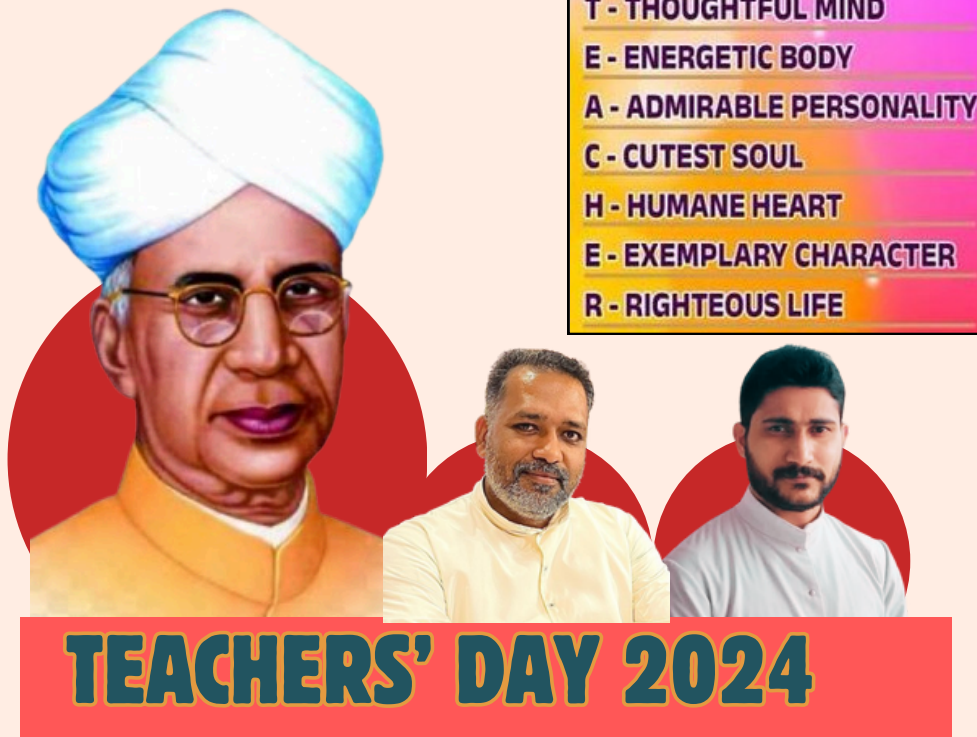

A JOURNEY OF COMPASSION

The students and staff of Mary Matha English Medium School had the opportunity to visit Asha Gram, A/P Ekambe, Tal – Koregaon, Dist - Satara and Asha Bhawan, A/P Kodoli, Dist - Satara where the differently abled children are taken care of, as the part of SEWA (Social Empowerment through Work Education and Action) Project. We started from school by 8.30 am. Our first visit was to Ashagram. It was a clean and beautiful place. Upon our arrival, we were immediately greeted by the warm smiles of the dedicated staff and volunteers who work tirelessly to provide care and love to both children and adults. In Asha Gram persons above 18 years are taken care of. They were also present at the entrance with their innocent smiles. The Director of the Asha Gram Rev. Fr. Thomas Thadathil MCBS detailed about the institution to the students. After hearing about the inmates of Asha Gram the mood of the students as well as teachers changed. Mr. Prashanth, a senior staff of Asha Gram was entrusted to take us to each and every corner of Asha Gram. He guided us well and escorted us everywhere. It was surprise to see that the mentally and physically challenged people were doing all kinds of work in their own way. They were skilled carpenters, press personnel, farmers and were talented in craft and aesthetic activities. We became astonished when the father said about the overall atmosphere of the Asha Gram: "The gate of the Asha Gram never closes but none of the inmates tries to go out of the gate!" They are free birds in the campus and are allowed to move everywhere inside. Some of the inmates reached upto our students and shook their hands with them. Students were very happy to join with them though many of their eyes were filled with tears.

Later we gathered in the auditorium where the students performed on the stage for the inmates of the friends of Asha Gram. Students representatives along with Principal Fr. Jino Thomas, Bursar Fr. Sachin Chacko, Project directors Mr. Lijo Kurian & Mr. Vishnu Kalel and the Heads of the Students' Council have together handed over the small amount which our schoolmates – both staff and students of all classes from Nursery onwards – have contributed for them. Finally the inmates presented a dance performance for us. It was fabulous and thoughtful for the students because their disability was not visible in the performance! Asha Gram arranged a delicious lunch for us after which we moved to the next destination - Asha Bhawan.

While on the way back, everyone felt how lucky we are to be enjoying all the privileges from the society and our families. It was an eye-opener, a grounding experience. One of the things that struck us most was how effortlessly we communicated; despite them being unable to communicate verbally, one could still hear the laughter that filled the room. It was a reminder that love and compassion knows no barriers; it transcends words. It reaffirmed my belief in the importance of service and reminded me that the true measure of a society lies in how it cares for its most vulnerable members. Hats off to the dedicated priests of Missionary Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament (MCBS) and the staff and sisters of various congregations who work at these institutions for such differently abled people.

Our students of Grades IX & X had a re-affirmation of this tone when they went back to their homes that day: "Together, we can make the world a kinder and more compassionate place, one small miracle at a time!"

ASHA BHAWAN IS A SPECIAL SCHOOL WHERE CHILDREN BELOW 18 ARE TAKEN CARE. WE REACHED THERE IN THE AFTERNOON. THE SIGHT OF ASHA BHAWAN WAS NOT LIKE ASHA GRAM BECAUSE INMATES OF ASHA GRAM ARE TRAINED BUT IN ASHA BHAWAN CHILDREN ARE BEING TRAINED. HERE WE CAN SEE MULTI-TALENTED, PHYSICALLY AND MENTALLY CHALLENGED CHILDREN. THANKS TO THE SPECIAL EDUCATORS WHO TRAIN THESE KIDS AS ANGELS. THE DIRECTOR OF THE INSTITUTION IS REV. FR. AJESH AND THE ASSISTANT DIRECTORS FR. PRINCE AND FR. ABHILASH AND THE STAFF WELCOMED THE STUDENTS AND THEY HANDED OVER THE COLLECTION THEY GATHERED FROM THE SCHOOL FOR ASHA BHAWAN. WITH HEAVY HEARTS STUDENTS STARTED TO OBSERVE EVERYTHING. THEY TALKED WITH TEACHERS TO HEAR THEIR EXPERIENCE. THEY TALKED WITH CHILDREN OF ASHA BHAWAN WITH TEARS-FILLED EYES. LATER THE STUDENTS PERFORMED A FEW DANCES ON THE STAGE FOR THE ASHA BHAWAN KIDS. THE CHILDREN OF ASHA BHAWAN TOO PERFORMED ON THE STAGE. FINALLY WITH THE MESSAGE FROM FR. AJESH THE VISIT ENDED. WE HAD TEA AND SNACKS FROM ASHA BHAWAN WHICH WAS ARRANGED BY THEM FOR US. WE RETURNED FROM THERE BY 4.45 PM.
